In the late 1920's, Mrs. Mollie Schlesinger's great passions were taking care of her daughter Betty and her son Jules, as well as serving her husband, Mr. Joseph

In June, 1950, Betty Schlesinger married Edward Domb and had two sons, Peter and Allan. In 2010 Allan opened Schlesinger's Restaurant and Delicatessen.
